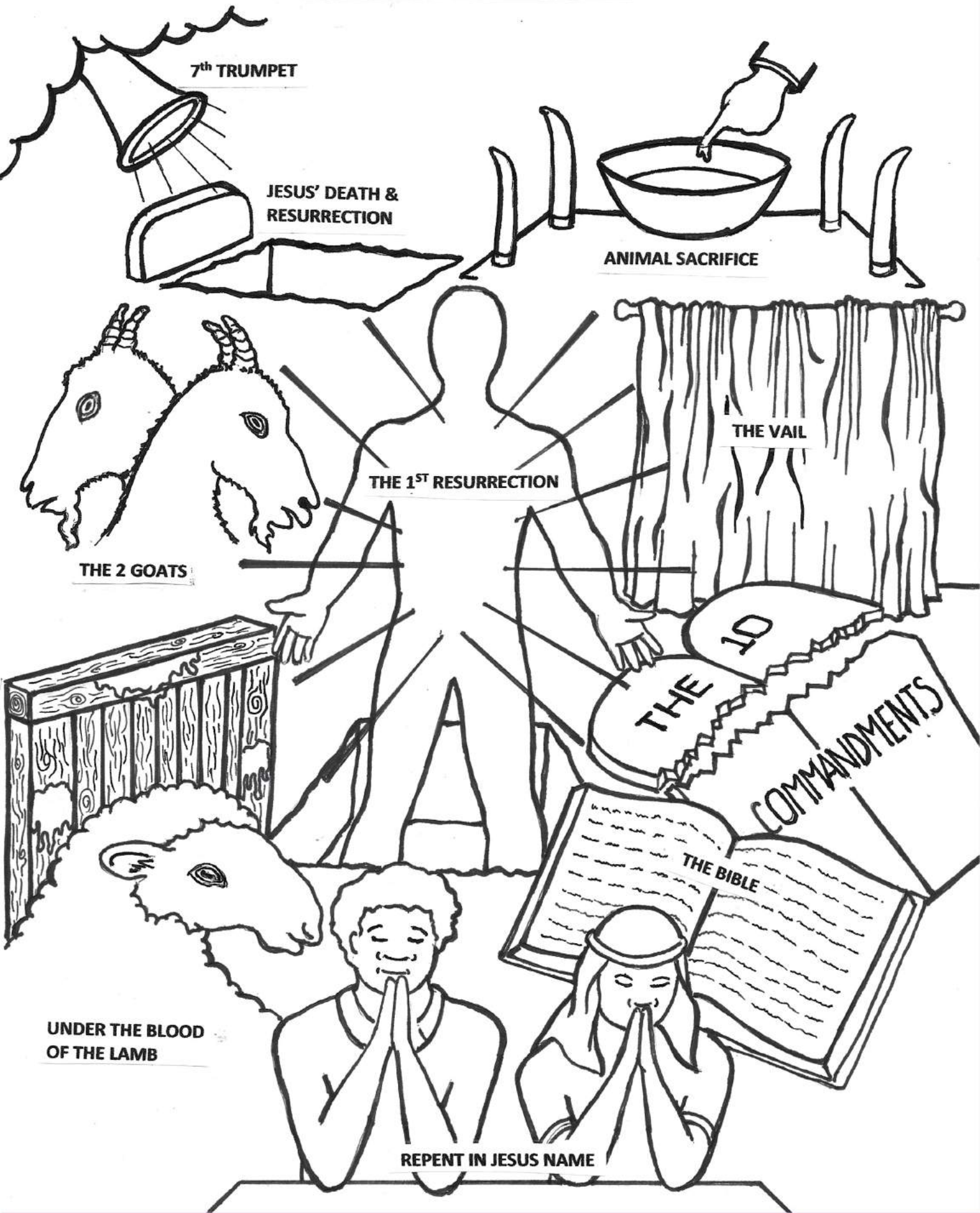

Lesson

In Leviticus 23rd chapter, Jesus commanded we keep a Day of Atonement. God said it is a Sabbath of rest for us. It is to be kept on the 10th day of the 7th month. We are to have a holy convocation on this day. A convocation means all families gather together to come worship the Lord. We are to afflict our souls on this day to share in the suffering in part of our Lord and Savior Jesus. Afflicting our souls simply means that we fast for one whole day. To fast means that we do not eat nor drink for one day. Also, we are to do no work whatsoever. We are not to go to work, nor do any manner of work in our homes. We are to keep God's word only in having the holy convocation.

We are flesh and blood. During the creation, Jesus stated that the evening and morning was one day. This means a new day begins when it's dark outside and ends when it gets dark again after 12 hours of light. When it gets dark outside on the 9th day, the 10th day has begun! This means it takes 12 hours of night plus 12 hours of daylight to complete one whole day. As soon as it gets dark outside again, one day ends and a new day begins.

And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying, Also **on the tenth day of the seventh month there shall be a day of atonement**: it shall be **an holy convocation unto you**; and **ye shall afflict your souls**, and offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord. And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the Lord your God. **Ye shall do no manner of work**: it shall be **a statute forever throughout your generations** in all your dwellings. **It shall be unto you a sabbath of rest**, ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at even, from even to even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

The Day of Atonement

Adam was made on the 6th day of the creation, but died at 930 years old. Had Adam not sinned, everyone would still be living to this day. The time the 7000th year had arrived in Adam's day, the Day of Rest was put on hold. All mankind was now given 7000 years more to become reconciled and restored back to God.

In the days of Moses, a 1st born male lamb was killed on the Passover. At this time, the Lord was about to deliver the children of Israel from slavery from the Egyptians. The lamb's blood was put on the doorposts so that the 1st born males in that time would not die. Everyone had to go under the blood of a lamb for protection. For those families who did not have the blood of the lamb on their doorposts, the 1st born child in those homes died. To live, they had to go under the blood of the lamb to live. Today, we go under the blood of the Lamb of God... Jesus.

The Laws of Animal Sacrifice were given to keep all mankind from being destroyed. When a person sinned by accident, an animal died for that sin. The high priest had to sprinkle the blood of the sacrificed animal about the altar seven times to be forgiven. Why seven times? God gave us all 7 days or 7000 years to live as flesh and blood. Remember that 1 day with the Lord is 1000 of our years!

If mankind was to become reconciled and restored back to God, an atonement had to be made for our sins to be passed-over! To reconcile means to bring back into agreement and harmony with, and to restore means to bring something back to where it was before. Someone, of flesh and blood had to live sin-free, die, and be resurrected to perform this very act!

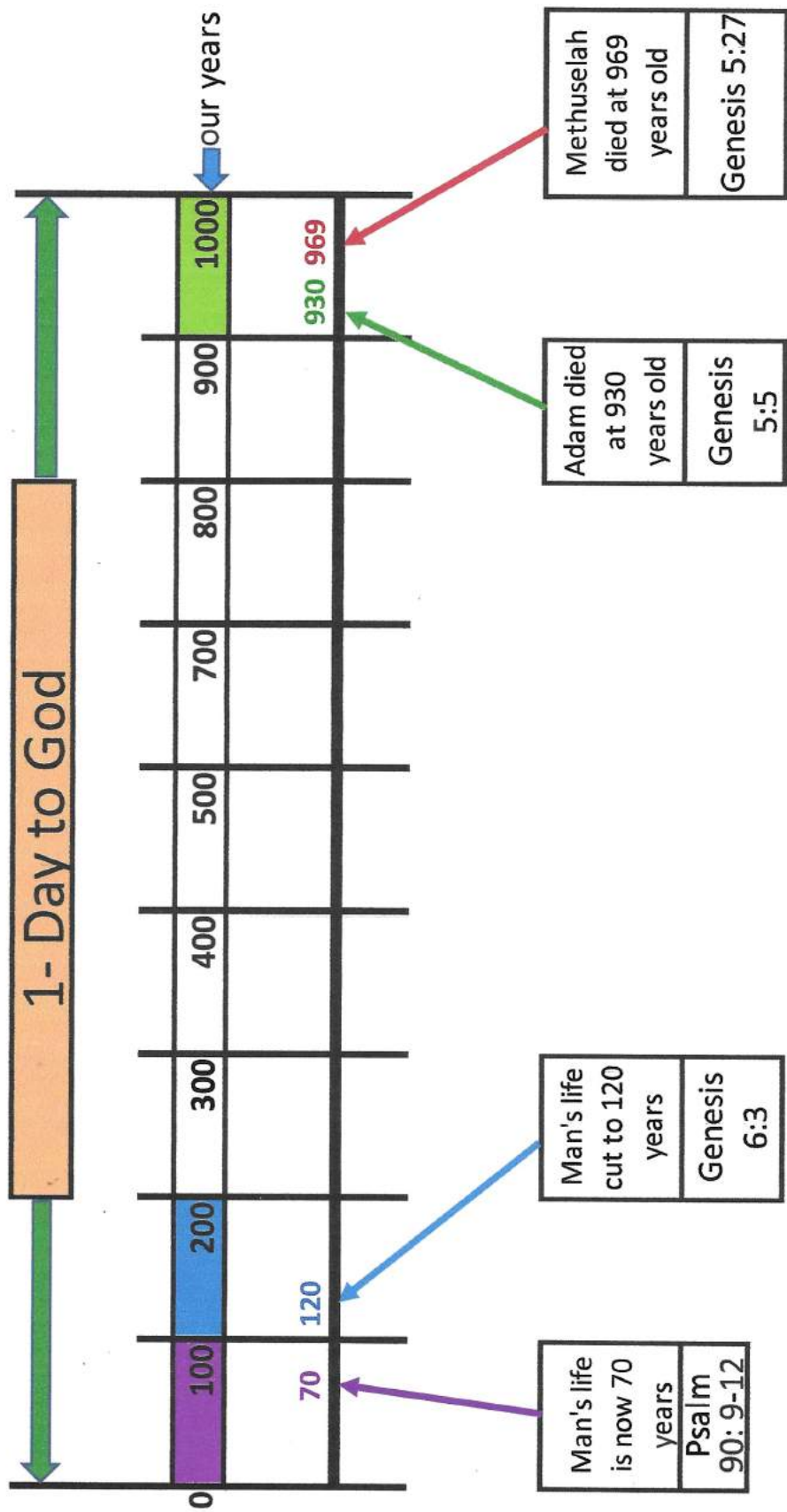
The 2 Goats

There was one problem with the Laws of Animal sacrifice! Animals didn't sin, man sinned! The Laws of Animal Sacrifice was added because of sin! The Lord never liked sacrificing animals. No one was worthy, that could sacrifice themselves by dying for the sins of everyone and still live forever.

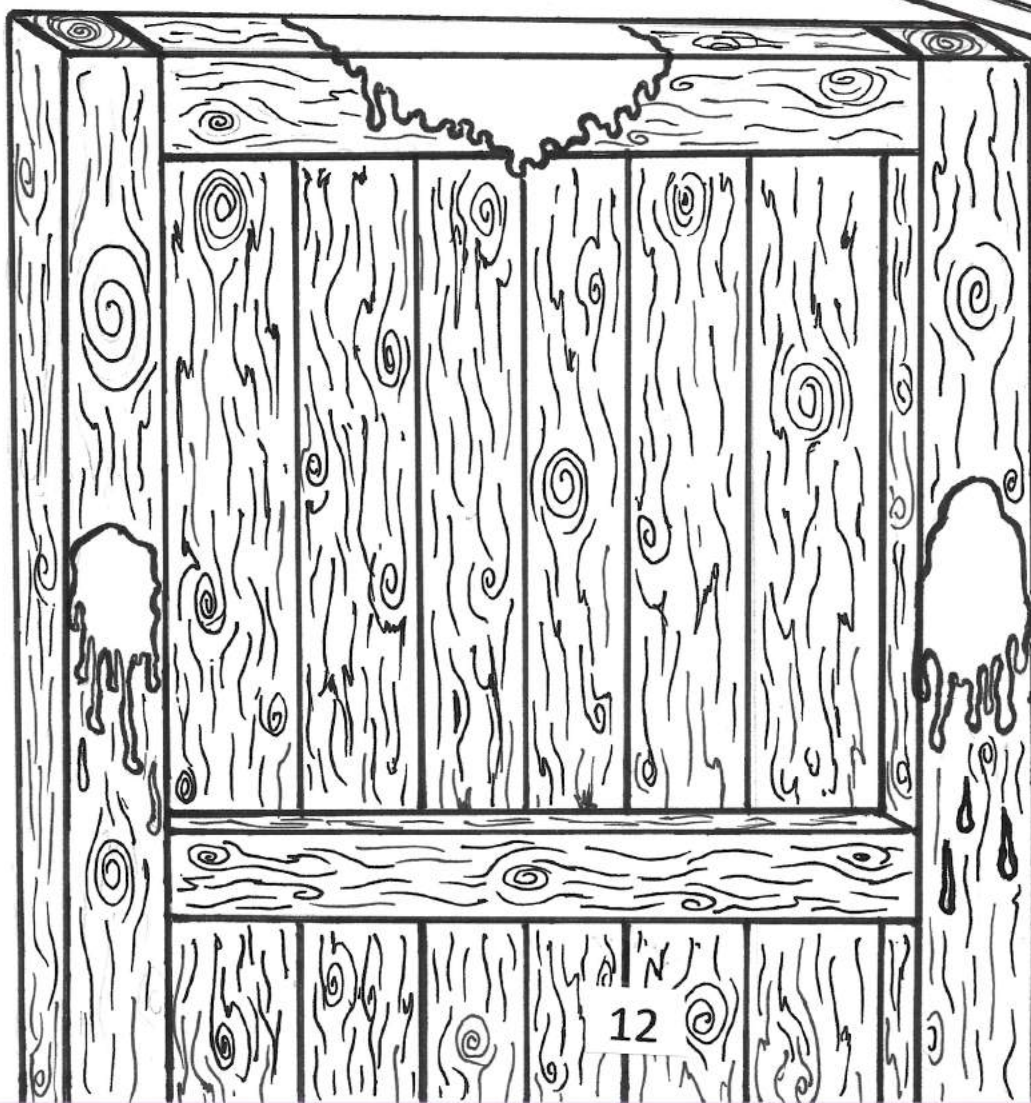
During the atonement under the Laws of Animal Sacrifice, the high priest took 2 goats. One goat was to be sacrificed and die for the sins of the people. Its blood was sprinkled about the mercy seat behind the veil. As for the second goat which was not killed, upon it was laid the confessed sins of the people, representing the resurrection of Jesus. The live goat was then taken and released into an uninhabited land and released.

The Lord was telling us that this is what Jesus was going to do when He came! Only our God Jesus could do this! To make an atonement for our sins, He came down from heaven and became a flesh

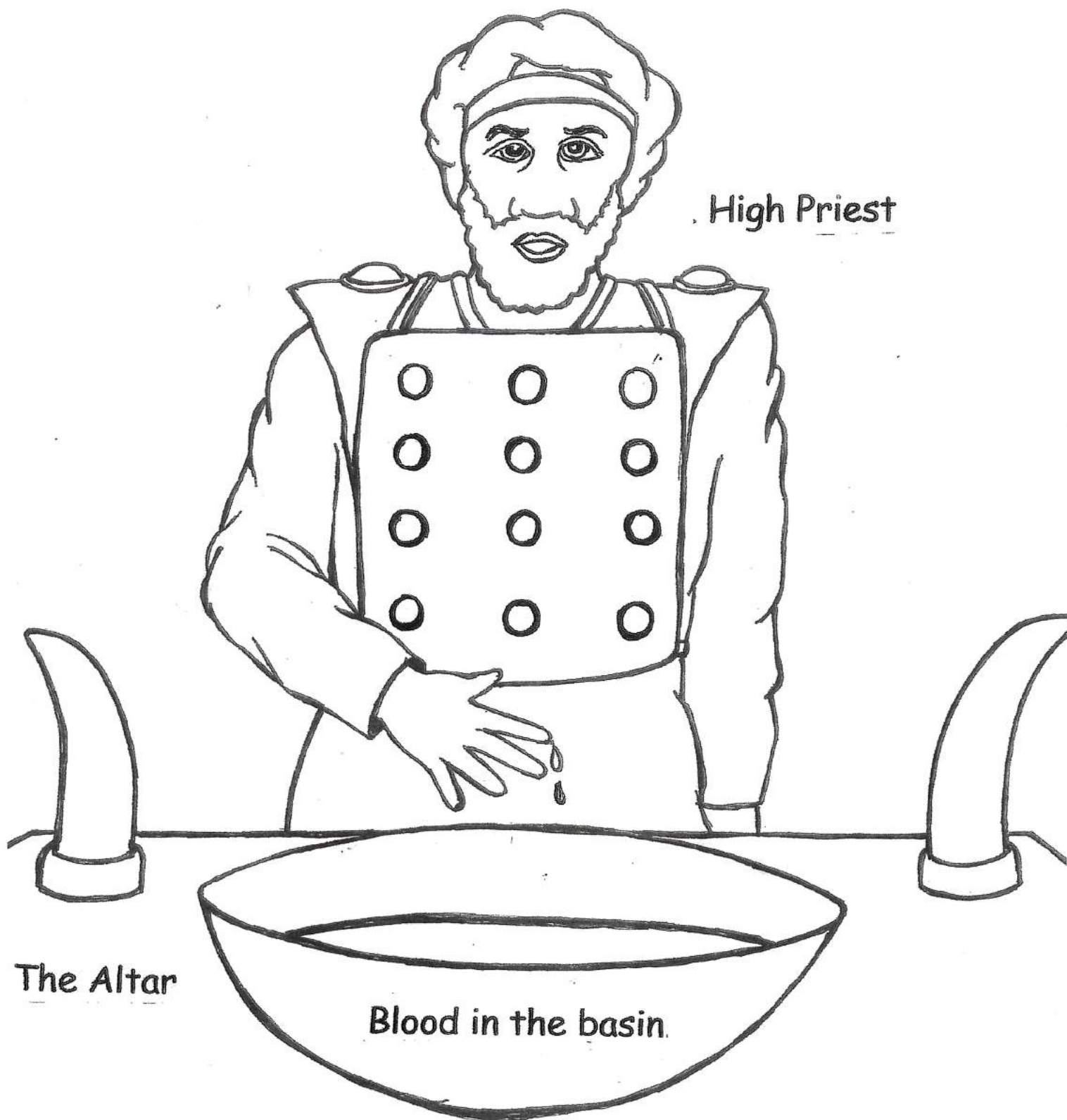

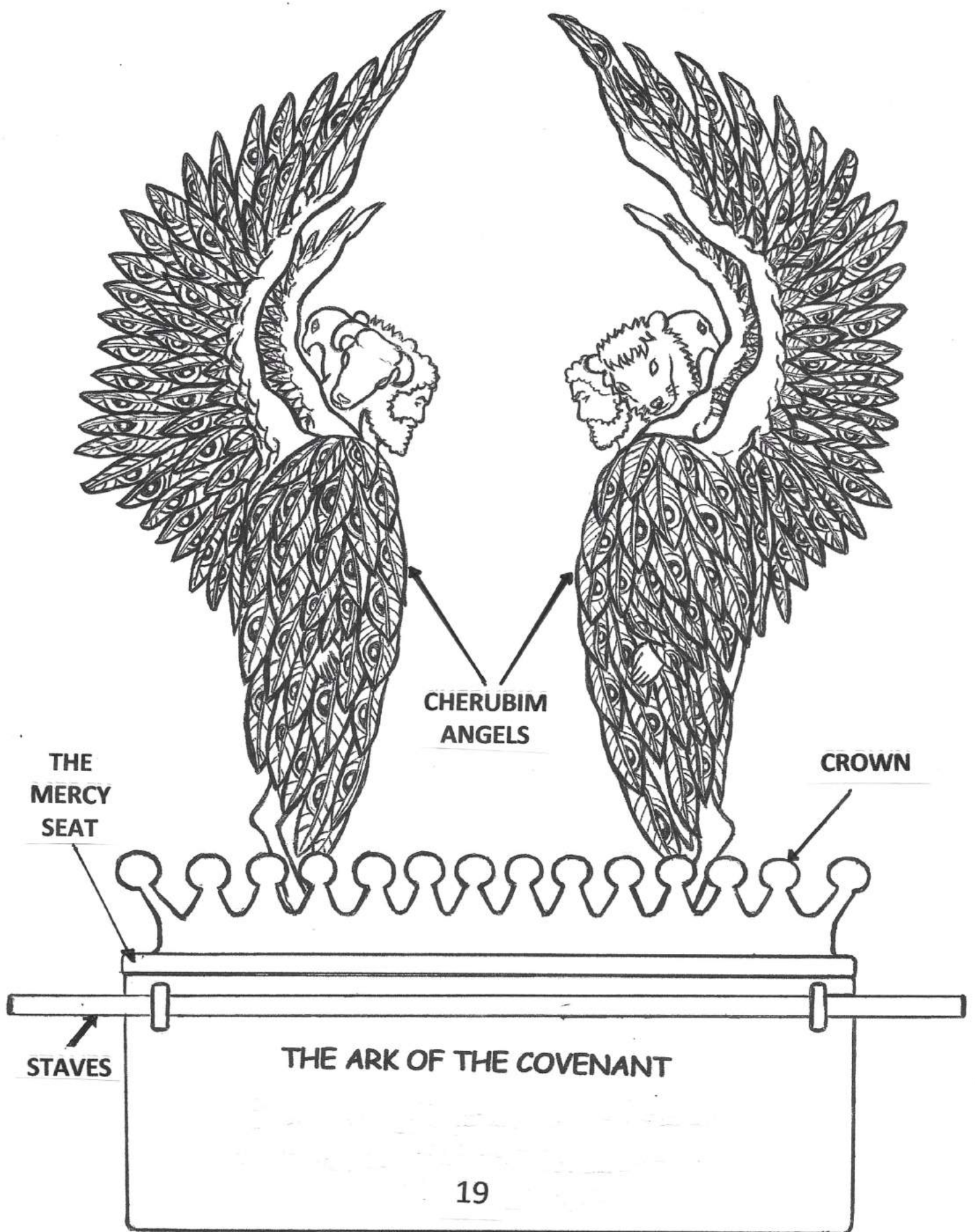
THE SCAPE GOAT

and blood person to live as we do. At the death of Jesus, the vail of the temple split. Only behind the vail, once yearly could the high priest go to sprinkle the blood of the sin offering to make atonement for sins. Since the vail of the temple split, there was no longer a need to sacrifice animals for our sins. The Laws of animal sacrifice was no more. Jesus obeyed the commandments and never sinned. Jesus reconciled us back to the Father and second, Jesus restored the chance to get eternal life. We must now go under the blood of Jesus for salvation; just as the blood of the lamb saved Israel in the days of Moses. Today, we now go through Jesus. By repenting and keeping all God's laws and statutes can we now live forever.

Although Jesus was killed, He died for our sins. He was resurrected 3 days and 3 nights later on the 7th day. Jesus was spirit again! He now sits next to the Father in heaven.

So, what does this tell us? It tells us that at the sound of the 7th trumpet, just before the 7th day, those who stopped sinning, repented and changed their lives too will become spirit at the 1st Resurrection! They will live forever in the good side of the kingdom of God. This means that we are in a place where we have a chance to be part of the family of God; after their kind, which is ...'Spirit'!

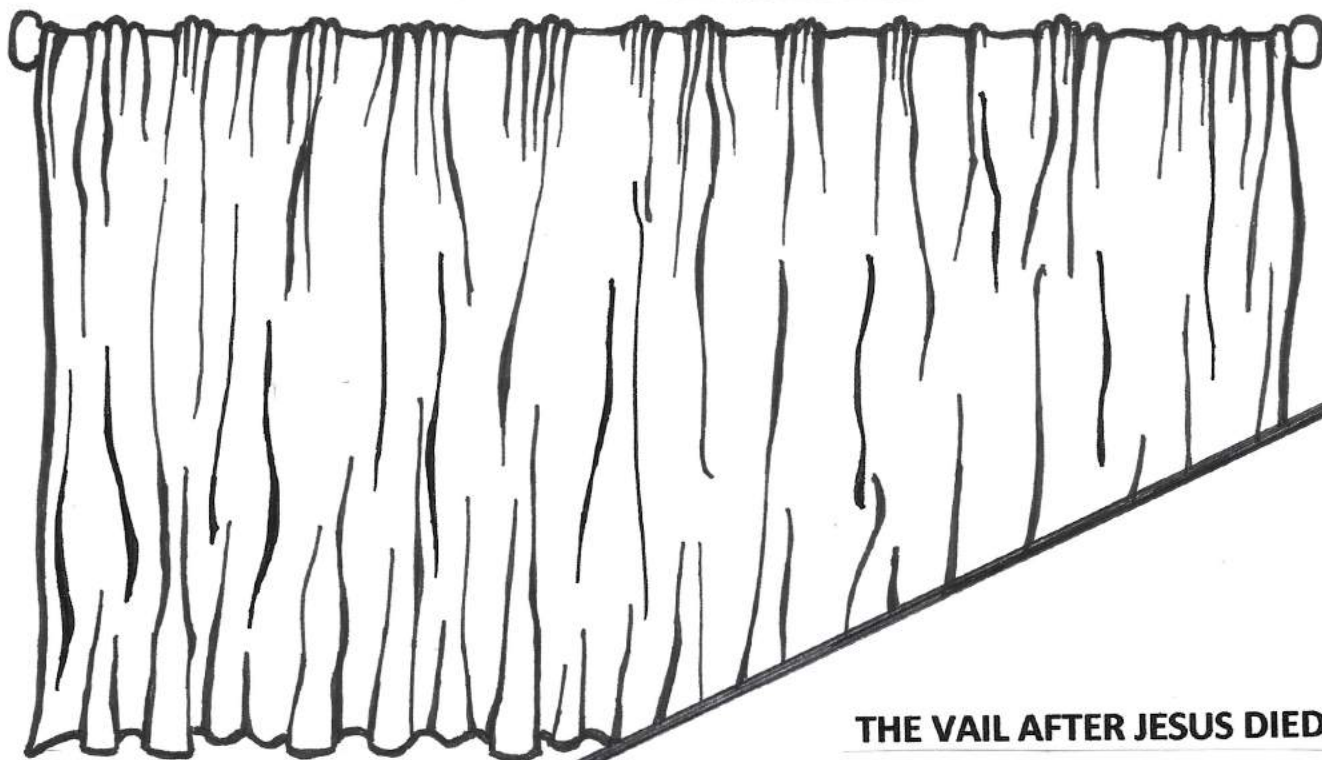
We can now be made after God's kind as well as in God's likeness and image. Flesh and blood can't be in the kingdom of God. We must be changed into spirit beings to live forever with Jesus and the Father. Jesus is the Tree of Life that Adam had access to in the Garden of Eden. After Adam sinned, mankind no longer had access to learn from Jesus. By Jesus making atonement for all of our sins, we are now reconciled and restored back to God, the Tree of Life.

Jesus only died once for our sins; therefore, we must never sin on purpose. Those sins will be on your head! We must keep the 10 Commandments and walk as did Jesus, who is our perfect example.

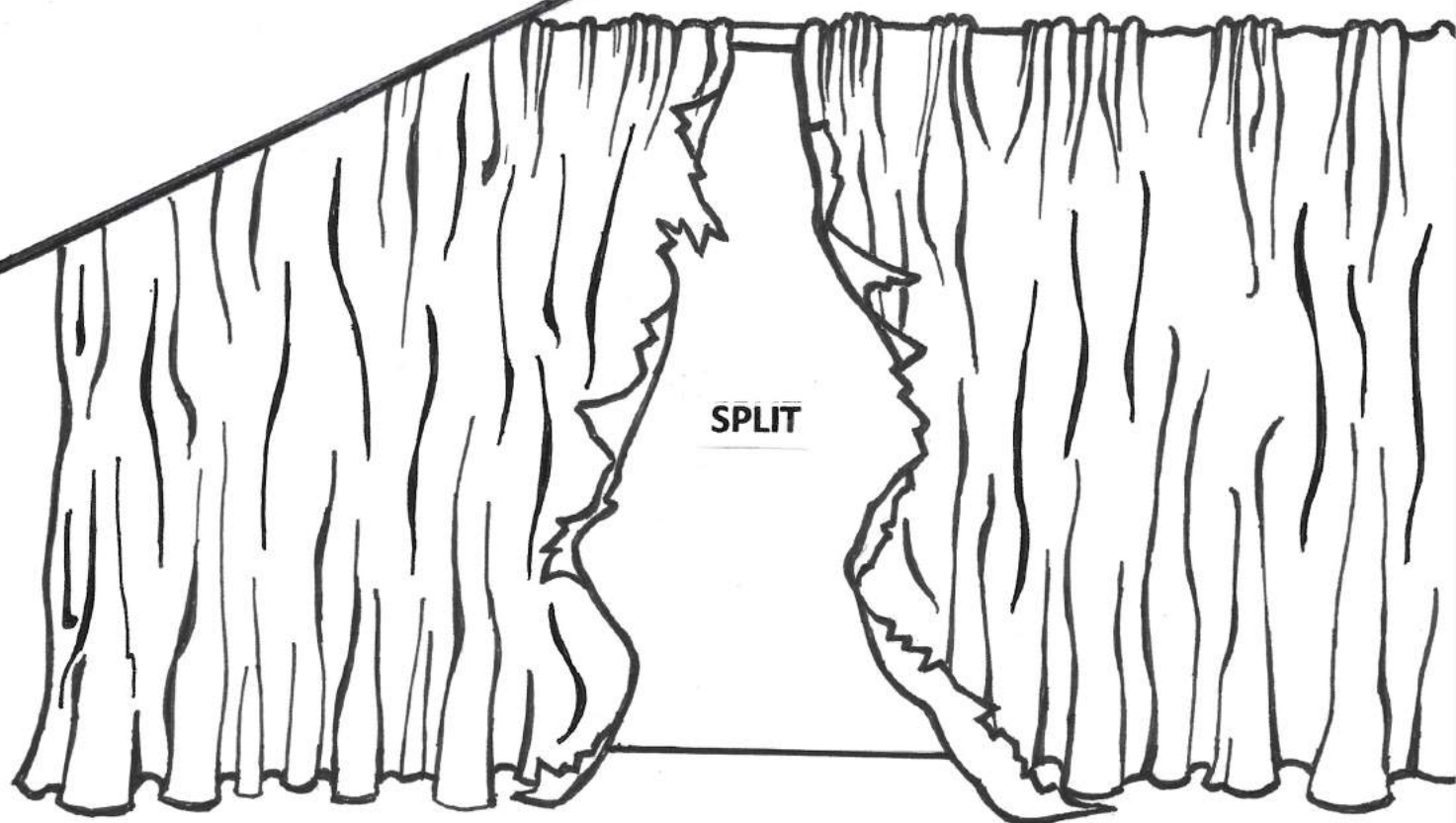

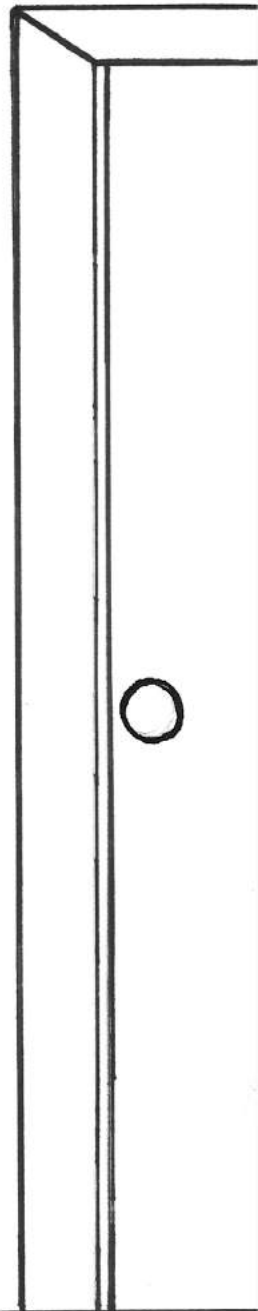
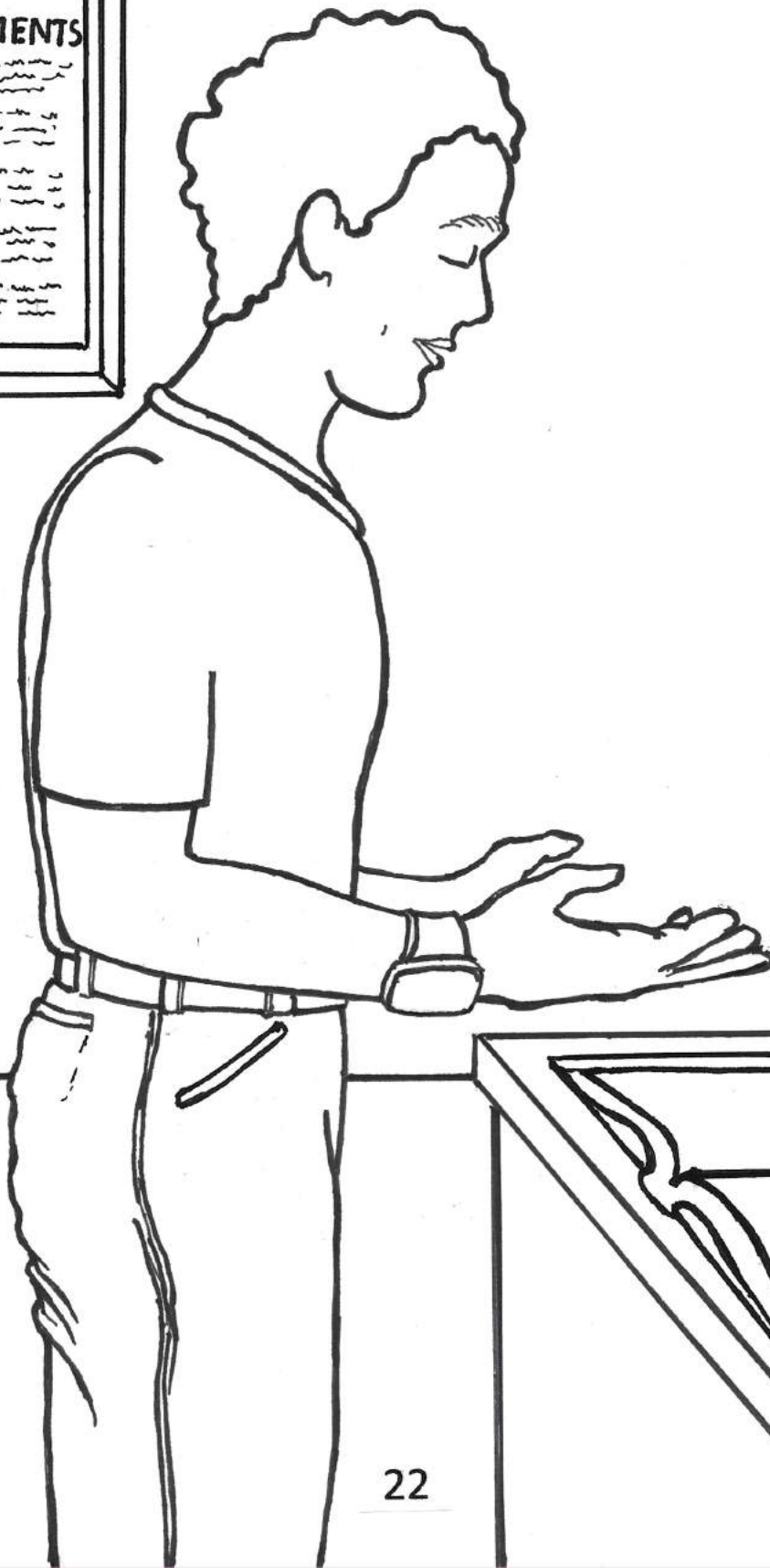
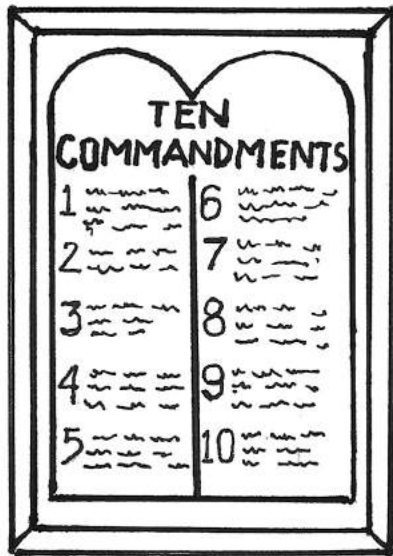


THE VAIL AFTER JESUS DIED

Then begins the 7th day or 7000th year known as the Day of Rest. Through His laws is how the entire world will live in peace! There is more than one definition of the word peace. 1. **Peace-** (Merriam-Webster) - a state of tranquility; calm; freedom from disquieting or oppressive thoughts or emotions. This is about peace in your mind.

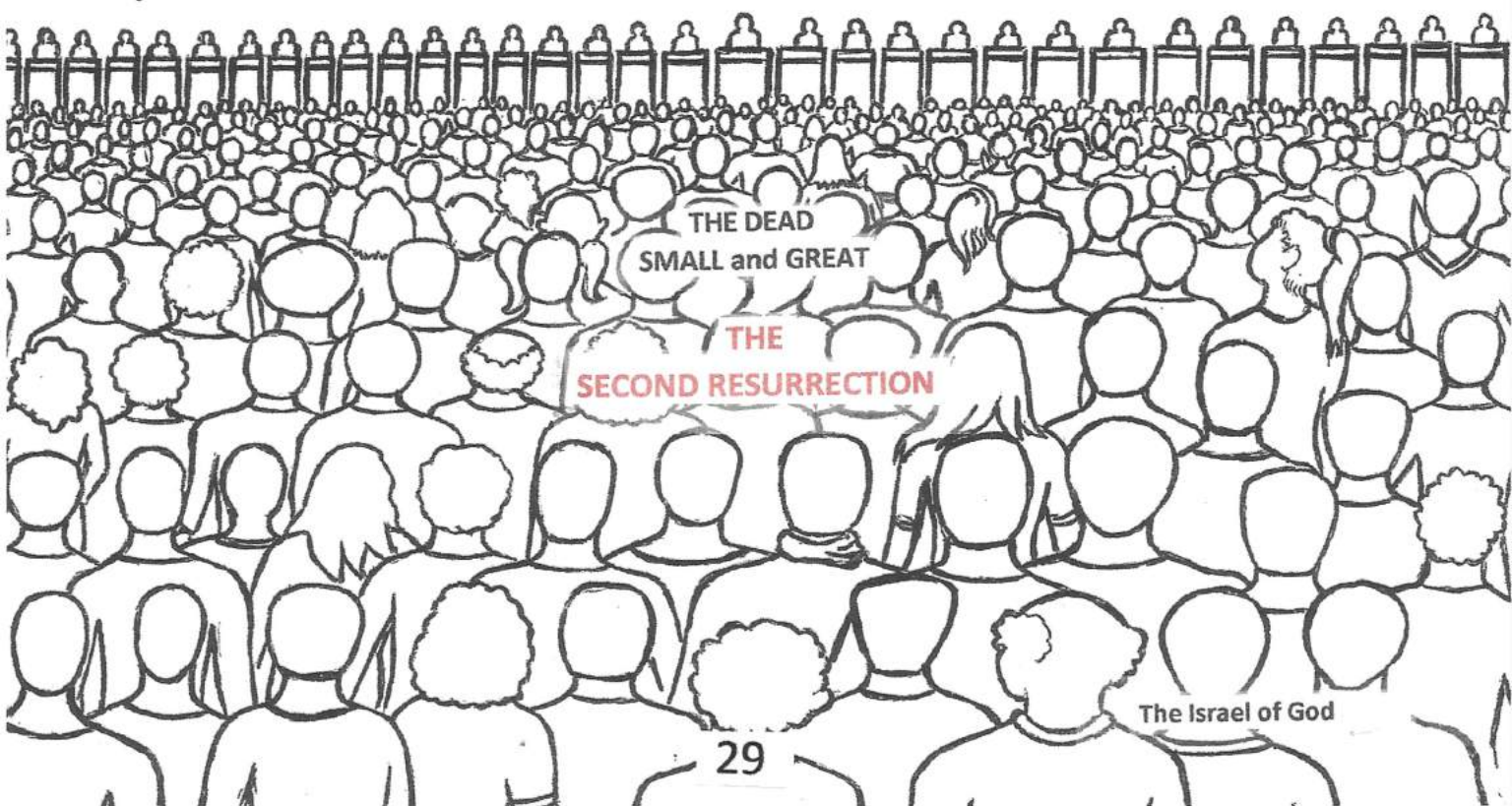
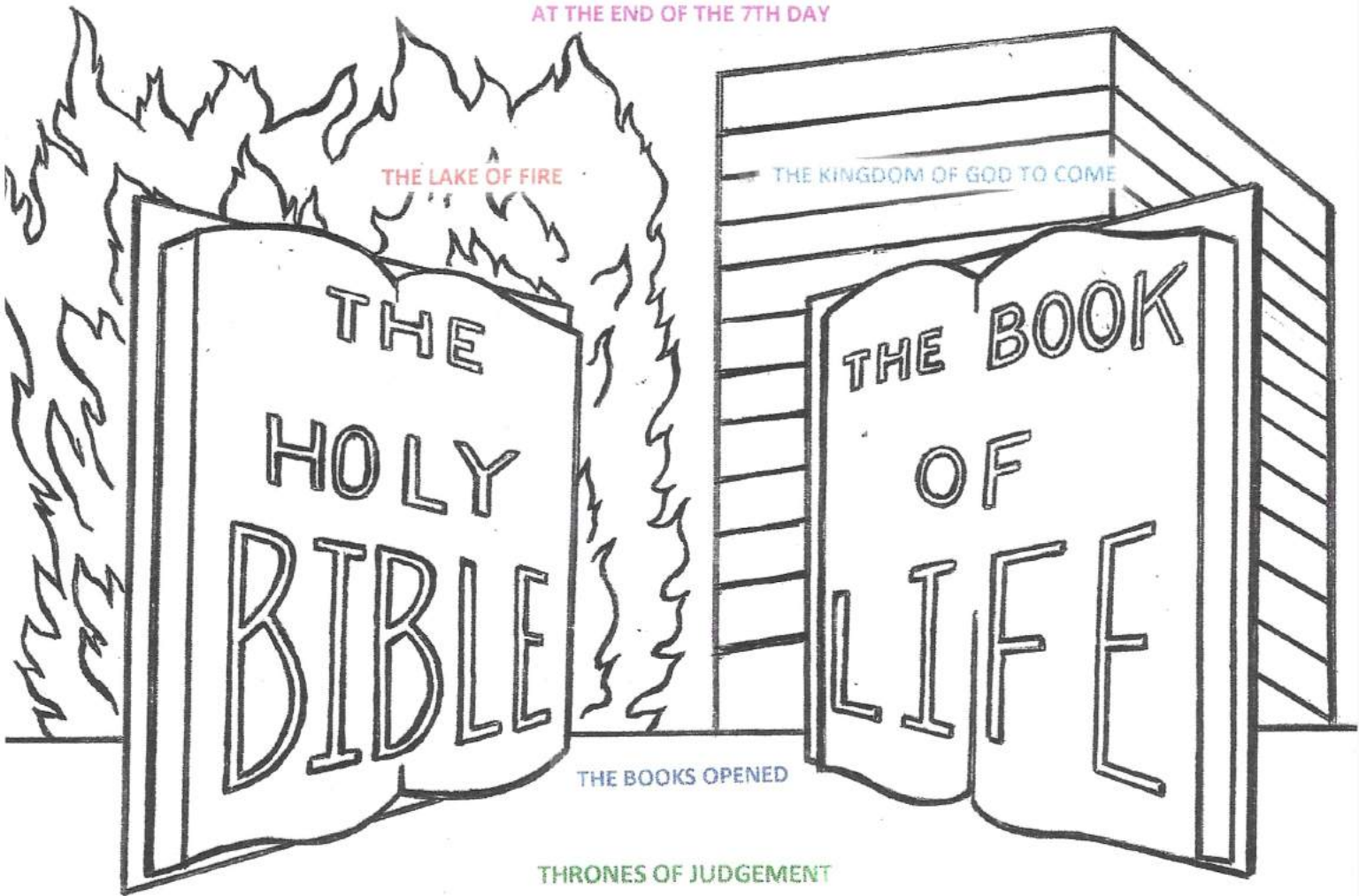
The Passover Completed
