

Lesson 53

Israel Prepares for the Passover and Their Deliverance from Slavery

Exodus 11: 1-10; Exodus 12: 1-28.

1. The Lord told Moses that He will bring one plague more upon Pharaoh and upon Egypt. 2. After this plague, the Pharaoh will let the Children of Israel go, thrusting them out of Egypt!

4. Moses was very great in the land of Egypt and in the sight of Pharaoh's servants and the Egyptian people. 5. Moses told the people that the Lord will go through Egypt and all the first-born from the Pharaoh to the maidservant behind the mill down to the first-born of the beasts will die. 6. At this tenth plague, there shall be a great cry throughout the land of Egypt! 7. The Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron telling them that this month is the first month of the year.

10. The lamb must be killed on the 14th day of the 1st month in the evening time. 11. Using a plant called hyssop, the blood from the death of this lamb is to be put on the two side posts and the upper door posts of their homes 12. Whether Israelite or Egyptian the lamb's blood is a token whereby when seen, the Lord will pass over that house and the first-born inside will not die.

15. All of the lamb is to be eaten that night with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. 16. Everyone must eat in haste with their loins girded and with their shoes on.

3. **(Recite)**- Every man and woman borrowed jewels of gold and silver from their neighbors, for the Lord gave Israel favor in the sight of the Egyptians.

8. **(Recite)**- Everyone is to take a male lamb for their house and separate it from the herd on the 10th day of the 1st month. 9. Their lamb must not have blemishes which are bruises and must be the first-born male.

13. **(Recite)**- All first-born of the souls or people inside that house shall be saved by the blood of the lamb. 14. Those with faith and believe the word of the Lord obeyed God's words!

17. **(Recite)**- They must be dressed and ready to leave Egypt, for it is the Lord's Passover. 18. To pass over means to go over and around something or someone and not touch them.

19. The Lord made the keeping of the Passover a yearly memorial. 20. He made the keeping of the feast days of unleavened bread an ordinance, which is a law. 21. Every generation is to keep these days. 22. As for the Feast of Unleavened Bread, we must eat unleavened bread for seven days. 23. The 1st and the 7th days of this feast are to be days of holy convocation to worship God.

24. **(Recite)**- Convocation means to come together in one place as we do every Sabbath Day. 25. No bread with leaven is to be found in anyone's home for seven days.

26. After Moses had called for all the elders of Israel, they took a lamb according to their families and kill them for the Passover. 27. They used hyssop to put the blood on the doorposts of their houses and was warned not to go outside until the morning! 28. When the Lord passes through the land of Egypt and sees the blood, He will not let the Destroyer go into that house. 29. Even when Israel finally reaches the land God promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, Israel must still observe the Passover and the Feast of Unleavened bread.

30. **(Recite)**- Today, we do not kill a lamb, nor do we put blood on the doorposts of our homes but, we do keep the service.
